This is a regular update on progress with the Millennium Challenge Corporation Vanuatu Project compiled by the Design and Build Contractor – Downer EDI Works Vanuatu Ltd on behalf of the Project Team.

MCA Update #27 Efate Ring Road & Santo East Coast Road

Highlight:

8.6 km of road have now been sealed.

Efate Work Done Last Week

The clearing crew are 8 km from Klem's Hill, while the side drain and pavement widening crew reached the top of the Creek Ai Hill, which is 9 km from Klem's Hill. The pavement overlay crew progressed through Tanoliu village and past Samoa Point. A small team continued with seal preparation between Malatia and Emua. Sealing was carried out on four days and has now reached Malatia with a total of 8.6 km sealed. The drainage team completed two deep culverts near the top of the Creek Ai Hill. A subcontract crew continued to install access ways and driveways for access on and off the new road between Safaki and Tanoliu.

Efate Work Planned for This Week

The clearing operation will progress to the Mangaliliu turnoff. The side drain and pavement widening crew will continue working on both sides of the existing road above the Creek Ai hill progressing towards the Mangaliliu turnoff. The pavement overlay crew will work past Samoa Point towards the Savannah Store. A small crew will continue to dress up and prepare sections between Siviri and Malatia for sealing. As weather permits, the sealing operation will progress towards Siviri. The drainage team will to work on several conventional culverts then install another set of special deep culverts close to the Mangaliliu turnoff.

Longer term we expect to start clearing at Safaki heading towards Takara, Onesua and Epule in mid August and be working on Klem's Hill pavement in late September/early October.

Safe Employee For Month of June

The Downer EDI Works Safe Employee for the month of June was Joel Kalsal. The award was to recognise Joel for his role in training - roller drivers and safe operation of the Cat 950 loader. Joel is from Erakor village and is part of the pavement crew. He is one of the longest-serving Downer Vanuatu workers. Originally he started work as part of the pavement investigation team in June 2008. He will be presented with his award at a workers meeting next week.

Santo Road
